Subject: Sanitary Sewer Standards

The Intergovernmental Joint Sanitary Sewer Technical Committee has issued an update to the “Sanitary Sewer Standards of the Urbana & Champaign Sanitary District and Affiliated Communities, Champaign, Urbana, and Savoy”. The effective date of this latest edition is January 1, 2012. The latest edition incorporates the January 1, 2007 revisions, the January 1, 2010 revisions, plus some new revisions and additions. Prior to issuance of this latest edition, the January 1, 2007 and the January 1, 2010 revisions have been appended to the April 12, 2000 Standards. All of the recent standards revisions and additions have been approved unanimously by the Joint Sanitary Sewer Technical Committee and signed by authorized representatives of each municipality.

The latest standard is now posted on the Urbana & Champaign Sanitary District website, <http://www.u-csd.com/>. Push the “Technical Standards” button. The January 1, 2012 standard supersedes all previous editions.

Additionally, in order to highlight the most recent additions and changes to the standards, a “FOR REFERENCE ONLY STANDARDS” copy is posted on the District web site. The “FOR REFERENCE ONLY STANDARDS” incorporates the January 1, 2006 and January 1, 2010 standards in regular text plus shows the proposed new revisions in red text. The “FOR REFERENCE ONLY STANDARDS” will be removed from the website after about 6 months.

The main revisions to the current standards include:

- Adding a requirement for new ductile iron pipe to be epoxy lined
- Adding a requirement to install manholes in service lines greater than 6”
- Adding Section 125 - CURED-IN-PLACE SANITARY LATERAL LINING STANDARDS
- Adding reference to Urbana’s Right of Way Standard for street and sidewalk work in Urbana
